What is a Chamber of Commerce?

We are a voluntary, member-supported, non-profit organization of business, industrial and professional people who are dedicated to developing, promoting and maintaining a sound and healthy economic climate for their community....in our case Ozark and Dale County.

Who Joins the Chamber?

Members include businesses of all sizes, from one-person shops to large corporations, as well as individuals interested in supporting the chamber and our community. In other words, people just like you.

What's In It For Me?

Members receive numerous promotional perks, exclusive advertising, networking options, and additional exposure for their small business, corporation or organization. Membership for a small business is less than \$16.00* per month.

Resources: The Chamber has many resources for small businesses and almost all of them are FREE!

Publicity Boost: Your business increases exposure in online and offline formats.

Example: Members receive an online listing (with a link) to help interested parties find you in searches. New Chamber members are entitled to one business card ad (You must claim the ad within 90 days of joining) in the Chamber's weekly newsletter for 4 consecutive weeks. We also provide relocation and visitors packets with information on businesses. These packets give the featured companies an edge over other businesses in the area.

<u>Membership = Credibility:</u> You can increase positive perception among consumers and business owners when you are identified as a member of the chamber of commerce.

Research shows that when consumers know a small business is a member of their local chamber, they are 44% more likely to think favorably of it and 63% more likely to purchase goods or services from the company in the future.

<u>Increased Visibility:</u> Chamber website listing, Facebook posting for your business events, promotions, achievements, etc. The chamber will also promote your grand opening, groundbreaking, or milestone event.

<u>Gain a Voice in Government:</u> Your chamber provides you with opportunities to meet your Representatives and Senators as well as local city and county officials.

<u>Make Business Contacts:</u> The chamber initiates more business-to-business commerce and more opportunities for networking and connecting local professionals than any other local organization.

<u>Customer Referrals:</u> Every day the chamber receives calls from individuals and businesses looking for businesses specific to their needs. Chambers refer chamber members. Are you missing out on referrals?
